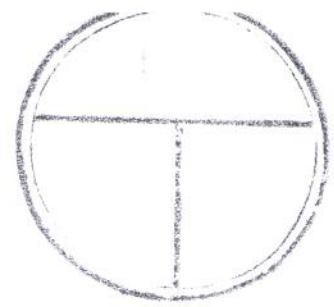



RULING ON MOTION ON NOTICE FOR STAY OF EXECUTION PENDING APPEAL

DATE-BAH, JSC (RETIRED): The letter 'Exhibit K' attached to the supplementary affidavit of the Appellant indicated that the Respondent represented to the Appellant that it was "holding action on the revocation of your authorization" This can reasonably be interpreted as meaning that the revocation of authorization was nullified, at least temporarily.

In the meantime, the appellant's application for stay of execution under regulation 9(2) of the LI 2235 had already been filed. This combination of circumstances indicates that this is an

appropriate case for the exercise of this Tribunal's power to grant a stay of execution of the decision of the Respondent, pending the determination of the Appeal and it so ordered
