KISSI AGYEBENG: (giving the ruling of the Tribunal)

- 1 The appellant operates a radio station – Radio Gold, broadcasting on 90.5 MHz out of the nation’s capital. It instituted the present appeal against a decision of the respondent in respect of its operations, which decision need not detain us here for reasons that become immediately obvious.
- 2 The appellant filed a notice of discontinuance of the appeal on 30 July 2019, a day before the Tribunal went on recess. The respondent has indicated before us that it is not opposed to the discontinuance.
- 3 We noticed that the appellant also prayed for liberty to reapply – which we understand to mean that the appellant is seeking our stamp to re-file the appeal should it desire to do so in the future. We are unable to grant this prayer. The appellant may well advise itself as to the amenability of the rules on reapplication in the terms and circumstances stated.
- 4 The appeal is accordingly struck out as withdrawn.
- 5 We make no order as to costs.
